Ethiopia is believed to be an origin of humankind and the birthplace of coffee. The word "coffee" came from "Kaffa", a coffee-growing region in South West of Ethiopia.

Ethiopia proudly embraces 9 UNESCO World Heritages.

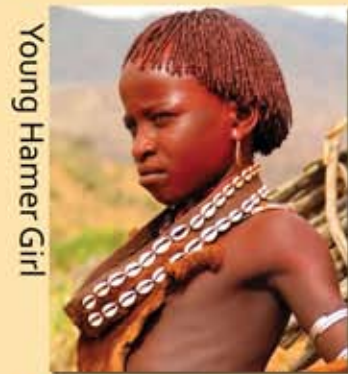


-  **Simien National Park**
The park is home to some extremely rare animals such as the Gelada baboon, the Simien fox and the Walia ibex, a goat found nowhere else in the world.
-  **Rock-hewn Churches, Lalibela**
One of the world's most astounding sacred sites: 11 rock hewn churches, each carved entirely out of a single block of granite with its roof at ground level.
-  **Fasil Ghebbi, Gondar Region**
The fortress-city of Fasil Ghebbi was the residence of the Ethiopian emperor Fasilides and his successors in the 16th and 17th centuries.
-  **Lower Valley of the Omo**
The site is a prehistoric site where many hominid fossils have been found. They are of fundamental importance in the study of human evolution.
-  **Axum**
Axum is the legendary birthplace of the Queen of Sheba, which allegedly houses the Ark of Conventant.
-  **Tiya**
The site contains 36 monuments, including 32 carved stelae covered with symbols, most of which are difficult to decipher.
-  **Lower Valley of the Awash**
-  **Harar Jugol - the Fortified Historic Town**
-  **Konso Cultural Landscape**



Ethnic Treasures

Over 80 different ethnic groups exist in Ethiopia. 50% of Ethiopia's ethnic groups live in south Omo Valley. Most famous are the Mursi with their clay lip plates and barbarian life style and the Hamar with colorful hair style and their bull-jumping ceremony.

Nature & Animals

Ethiopia has a rich variety of wildlife that can be rated among the best in Africa. More than 845 species of birds & 260 species of mammals are registered. Out of these, more than 50 are indigenous to Ethiopia.

National Parks

There are nine national parks in Ethiopia: the Simien Mountain National Park (in the northern mountain massif); the Awash National Park (east of the capital); the Omo and Mago National Park (southwest of the capital); the Shalla-Abijatta Lakes National Park (south of the capital); the Gambella National Park (Gambella region); the Nechi Sar National Park; Yangudi-Rassa National Park; and the Bale Mountains National Park, on high southern moorland country, which has its own unique flora and fauna.
